



Sometimes a hospital is the right place for you to be....

While you are choosing to birth your baby at home there are times when transport to the hospital is necessary. In the event that transport is necessary, I will remain with you, if you wish. When we transport, I am your Midwife & your advocate, however I am no longer your primary care provider.

In our area if there is a suspected problem with your baby, Rogue Valley Medical Center is the best place for your baby and the ambulance will be the mode of transport. If it is a problem with the mom, and we have time to decide we will most likely go to the nearest hospital. If it is appropriate for us to bring you in our own vehicles, I will ride with you. If it is appropriate for us to call for an ambulance, it is the paramedics who decide.

A copy of your full chart will be given to the hospital when we arrive and I will convey what I believe is most important at the time. Your family will be fully informed and I will stay with you until you are comfortable and you are settled postpartum.
